## KENTUCKY AWARD

The Kentucky Award was created and designed by the Kentucky Professional Photographers Association to be given to deserving individuals who have served the Association, fellow photographers and the profession of photography. To be nominated an individual does not have to be a member of KPPA, may have received the award previously, and, in fact, may be a group or family. The award is not automatically given each year. It is presented only when a candidate is found who has given **outstanding, above the norm** service to the association, fellow photographers and the profession.

In 1995, the Board of Directors of KPPA decided to solicit nominations from the general membership for the Kentucky Award to increase their ability to select the most worthy person to receive it. Note that the Kentucky Award is for service to the Association and within the state. See the National Award nomination form for service to photography outside the State Association or for service to the State Association on a National level.
